## **GIRLS, GIRLS, GIRLS!!**

There are 2 excellent Girls programs running outside of school next term: Circle of Girls for Grade 5&6 students and SHINE for 14-17 year olds. If you have a girl in either of these age brackets, who you feel struggles with her relationships with you (the parents) and/or her peers and may be at risk socially and emotionally in Secondary School, these groups would be perfect for them. Below are the details, you can contact them directly to refer.



**Want to learn some new ways to discover yourself?**

*Circle Of Girls* is a program for young women experiencing difficulties dealing with their emotions, struggling with significant relationships and many other issues.

The program runs once a week over eight weeks and covers topics such as: communication, feelings and emotions, self-esteem and confidence, assertiveness, strategies for getting past anger, relationship building and personal safety. A parent forum after session six is also an important element of the program.
